

DSBconnect Does Not Remember Passwords

Some web sites you visit may ask if you would like your computer/device to save your username and password. This may seem like a convenient way to login, but it may leave you susceptible to fraudulent logins. Letting your computer/device prefill both the username and password could potentially allow anyone who gains access to your computer/device the ability to login as you (although they would be presented the security question that they should not know the answer to).

Our new DSBconnect is coded to not allow passwords to be saved for future logins. It does, however, allow usernames to be remembered. You can click the "Remember Username" box on the login page to prefill your username for future logins. You also can click "Remember This Device" below the security question answer box. By selecting these two boxes, you will need to type only your password to login to DSBconnect.
